

Pruning

Tree pruning is generally completed in late fall or during the winter. Trees and shrubs need pruning for two primary purposes: to establish basic structure and to provide light throughout the plant so that they can mature in a well defined manner. Training a tree correctly will produce a healthier, less stressed, disease resistant, longer living plant. We prune to manage tree size, to remove crossover and diseased branches as well as removing water shoots and suckers. Horticultural oil and a fungicide should be applied on the trees after pruning to help protect against insect infestation and fungal problems in the spring.
